YES to fair wages at Youth Employment Services!

We work in a non-profit agency, providing hope to youth seeking work. We have a high success rate in placing youth in jobs. Every year we serve more youth than in the previous year.

We are the first point of contact to employment for many of our service users. We believe that our workplace should model the dignity that work affords.

Unfortunately, like many Torontonians, we can barely get by on our salaries, and yet the President of YES received a salary increase of almost 30% over the last five years.

AIR WAGES ARE POSSIBLE AT YES:

- We are the lowest paid in Toronto compared to others doing the same work.
- We have 1 manager for every 2 workers.
 This does not make any sense.
- The President of YES, Nancy Schaefer, got a 28.6% raise since 2005. She makes over 140,000 working for a non-profit agency of 30 unionized staff and 17 managers.

We have been bargaining since December 2009. On June 11 we rejected a tentative settlement and on June 28 we voted 89% in favour of a strike.

We will be in a strike position on August 16, 2010, unless the employer supports fair wages and benefits.
