Bargaining Update

47 OPSEU units remain in bargaining and, of these, 41 have now filed for conciliation. In addition, there have been five strike votes, all of which have given a strong strike mandate to their bargaining teams. As the October 6 provincial general election approaches, developmental services units are showing a unified front. We must keep up the pressure with MPPs and information pickets as we demand that the employer return to the Provincial Discussion Table.

DS workers take on Bay Street

More than 100 OPSEU activists and our supporters held an information picket outside a Bay Street Liberal fundraiser on August 18. Buses brought in developmental services demonstrators from as far away as Windsor and London.

Local 166 Community Living London president, Deb Morphew, stopped the Minister of Health and Long Term Care, Deb Matthews as she headed in to the event. Immediately addressing the critical lack of sector funding, Morphew told Matthews that this has created a waitlist of 8000 people with developmental disabilities in Ontario. These people end up in long term care when they have no where else to go. She urged the Minister to tell Dalton to get the parties back to the Provincial Discussion Table.
