This is no way to run Correctional Services

365 days a year, the men and women who run Ontario's Correctional facilities and supervise offenders in the community are working to ensure the people of Ontario stay safe. But thanks to a government that is ignoring calls for improvements, this comes at a high price for the workers, and the people they are trying to protect.

Overcrowded, dangerous facilities are resulting in hundreds of assaults on staff every year, and those numbers are climbing. Unmanageable caseloads and inadequate staffing means offenders on probation and parole get less supervision in the community. The Auditor General reports that government is spending so little, it puts the public at undue risk.

The men and women on the front line of Ontario's Correctional Services are fighting for improvements to make everyone safer: the staff, the offenders, and our communities. It's time to spend money where it counts: Better staffing, better training, better safety equipment.
