

ParaMed home care workers need a raise!

Simcoe/Muskoka **ParaMed** pays home care workers \$16.67 to 19.70 per hour. It takes 9 years to get to the top of the wage grid.

ParaMed's insulting offer during record inflation:

- 8 cents/hour in year 1 to workers earning \$16.67
- Nothing at all for 3 years for workers earning \$19.70

ParaMed is the largest home care corporation in Canada, owned by for-profit giant **Extencicare**. They got a 5% increase in government funding last year. They can afford to pay a living wage.
